The purpose of this letter is to have the here-with provided and thus begin action too The Integrity Section of NSW Police and too The Minister for Police.

On 22nd May 2012 I delivered too NSW Police Headquarters Parramatta a document for the attention of Detective Inspector Gary Jubelin and Strikeforce ANCUD titled:

A DETAIL REGARDING THE DEATHS OF  
Evelyn Greenup     Colleen Walker     Clinton-Speedy-Duroux

Upon follow up telephone calls and communicays it was that I met Detective Inspector Jubelin and Detective Sergeant Glenn Richardson on 28th November 2012 in the foyer of Parramatta Headquarters.

It was verbally confirmed by Detective Inspector Jubelin that he had forwarded the document to the Commissioners Office.

In result of a due process block of time I next requested to speak to Detective Inspector Jubelin on 18<sup>th</sup> February 2013 only to be informed by a Detective Sergeant Constable Kilani that Detective Inspector Jubelin was in a twelve month without pay suspension.

I furthered documentation concerning Strikeforce ANCUD and requests to be spoken too directly. They were countered with a declaration that mail addressed to Detective Sergeant Richardson dated 8<sup>th</sup> March 2013 he had not received nor did he receive that same communicay personally handed too Detective Oldfield on 20<sup>th</sup> March 2013. Detective Sergeant Richardson in my final telephone call (5<sup>th</sup> August 2013) was highly offensive and totally ludicrous in his declaration.

I redirected my approach directly to The Commissioners Office. I provided all documentation and informed the Commissioners Office of all interactions between myself and the relevant commands at Police Headquarters. My last received correspondence was from R Johnson Manager, Secretariat Office of the Commissioner of Police LN: D/2013/204941 that informed instruction was given to the relevant command to address my 16 September 2013 communicay. Such was reciprocated by Detective Superintendent M Willing in a 1 November 2013 correspondence that declared my request for answers to a number of critical questions been rejected

“not in the public interest”.

I followed through with further communicays too The Commissioners Office and to Detective Inspector Jubelin. Neither was reciprocated. This is the principal of this here communicay too inform such.

I forth know that a enormous number of revelations that were disclosed in the documentations would have been/were unknown to Strikeforce ANCUD and have no doubt, would greatly aide in resulting correct justice. It also is that in the compiling of the documentations my research unravelled a documented trail of NSW State Lottery fraud and a outlay of data that lays a high probable of match fixing in cricket matches involving Australia. Neither of these issues has been addressed along with evidence provided too the Commissioners Office of Detective Inspector Jubelin been in the foyer of a Sydney massage parlour that has a distinct probability of having a direct connection to the –wrongful- concerning the deaths of Evelyn Greenup; Colleen Walker and Clinton Duroux. (Evidence provided after the 2013 suspension.)

Due to uncertainty ov correct process and the bulk ov the documentation I believe it reasonable that your section can gather all from the Commissioners Office.

I inform that my last communicay mailed to Detective Inspector Jubelin in my knowledge is not before the Commissioners Office. That communicay too Detective Inspector Jubelin was sent via registered mail (509503581011) on 14 March 2014. It was

incorrectly dated 13<sup>th</sup> March 2013. The correct date should have been 13<sup>th</sup> March 2014.

I request to be informed in a soon as possible time as to what is the begin with course ov action your section needs or is going to enact.

## State Crime Command

In reference to your September 2014 correspondence – No: LM11404010

Your correspondence closed in hope that I can appreciate the reasons for the decision. I inform that I do understand the reasons for the decisions in this conscious regard. It is that the upper tiers of NSW police; Victorian police; the Australian Commonwealth parliament; NSW and Victorian parliaments recognise that the façade of pursuant justice under the unit name Strikeforce ANCUD is within the DETAIL and accompanying communications disclosed as exactly that.

I hope yourself appreciates the magnitude of shock and at times almost overwhelming disbelief that has become my learning in what is now three years of much trepidational concern. I want to make clearly understood. I was already very politically motivated and agendered before I watched Australian Story in 2007; the time first when I became known of the Bowraville sacrifices. I began in that moment and late into my inquiries totally in the belief that one of the victims; Evelyn Greenup was my daughter. This I made known to police in my first interaction at police headquarters. I was in such belief long into my inquiries and even to this point of time I hold some thinking that such may be fact in result of the labyrinth of deception in everything concerning Strikeforce ANCUD and my transient lifestyle of the mid 1980's. Never once in my interactions either directly or indirectly did I regard that police addressed me in this actual.

The political that I became to learn was totally unbeknown to me and in no question do I have; the pre-disposition taken by Detective Superintendent Willing - not in the public interest - actually declares no further action as it not be in the interest of The Family.

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Referring directly to your 25 September 2014 correspondence.

I received reply from the Customer Assistance Unit in correspondence dated 22<sup>nd</sup> September 2014. In only three days you signatored your completed response.

I inform: I did not receive your correspondence in my mail box until 1 October. This equals six days. Even accounting the two days in the weekend, from my experience with general mail within NSW this is a unusually lengthy time. As outlined in my 19<sup>th</sup> September communication too the Customer Assistance Unit, failure to receive communications concerning myself with Strikeforce ANCUD too and within NSW police is fact.

In your second paragraph you stated that you have determined that the material presented by me has been reviewed by the appropriate investigation team.

I request: Who in names and position was that appropriate investigation team?

Also I note that you phrased – the apparent murders of the three persons mentioned - . Perhaps I could interpret this as the first declaration from within NSW police that the three deceased persons were not murdered but were in fact sacrificed.

As well you advised that the investigative team assessed my material provided - as been minimal assistance to the investigation - .

Perhaps it is to your unknowing ; that in my convene with Detective Inspector Jubelin and Detective Sergeant Richardson on 28 November 2012 it was unequivocally answered “Yes” by Detective Inspector Jubelin too the question – Is the ongoing investigation relevant/inclusive ov information within the DETAIL? Within this fact it is that Detective Inspector Jubelin forwarded the DETAIL too the Commissioners Office not I. Such makes the determination by the investigative team implausible.

Also you declared -I have also determined - that I had been advised, - on a number of occasions that any further material you provide, or any contact you attempt to initiate, which does not relate to fresh information, will not be acknowledged or responded to by NSW police -. That is totally false except to say that within the ludicrous; inept replies (not only within the 5 September 2013 telephone call) by Detective Sergeant Richardson it became very clear he wanted nothing to do with anything regarding Strikeforce ANCUD; breaking to a declaration ov admitting that he never was on Strikeforce ANCUD (contrary to what was declared at the 28 November 2013 convene). Neither did he counter my allegation that in fact there never has been a active Strikeforce ANCUD.

Neither have I been instructed ov such in any correspondence from any command ov NSW Police.

Fact is: My 13 March 2014 communicay too Detective Inspector Jubelin did provide new information directly relevant to Strikeforce ANCUD and the closing request was objective and reasonable.

In close: I appreciate your diligence to file my inquiry under Part 8A of the Police Act 1990. I however presently regard that yourself remains either selectively ignorant or ignorant to the full extent ov my complaints. The accompanying copies ov communicays word through the incompetence that I have been dealing with either in result ov fear; induced incompetence or pure ignorance from the result ov the platform ov lies Strikeforce ANCUD was established on.

I conclude: Your 25 September 2014 correspondence made no reference to the information I provided that disclosed evidence ov NSW Lottery fraud and match fixing in cricket matches involving Australia.

A declaration to what action is been conducted regarding these revelations is my request. As well no comment was made regarding the evidence concerning Detective Inspector Jubelin in a massage parlour.

I request reciprocation that addresses these points ov issue and a answer to the question on the here-with first page. I also request a declaration resultant from reading the accompanying communicays as too what your now position is regarding the failure ov the Commissioners Office and Detective Inspector Jubelin to reciprocate.
